Dear Ellisfield Resident,

10 years ago, while we were discussing with HCC Highways, the implementation of a 30mph speed limit on the Axford Road, your Parish Council conducted a survey asking for residents' views: should the speed limit be just for the Axford Road area of Ellisfield, or for other parts of the village. The result of the 2008 survey was in favour of an Axford Road speed limit but that it should not extend throughout the whole village.

10 years on we have been asked to retest opinion. We see no reason not to.
